



About ABLÉ

ABLE (Achieving A Better Life Experience) accounts allow people with disabilities to save money without jeopardizing means-tested benefits such as SSI or Medicaid.

Who is Eligible

Any individual who has the onset of disability before the age of 26 and meets one of the following:

- Is eligible to receive benefits based on disability (like SSI or SSDI)
- Has a disability certification signed by a physician declaring individual meets social security definition of disability

Qualified Disability Expenses

- Health, prevention, and wellness
- Housing
- Education
- Employment training & support
- Transportation
- Assistive technology and personal support services
- Financial management and administrative services
- Legal Fees
- Expenses for oversight and monitoring
- Funeral and burial expenses

Alabama ABLÉ Features

- Contribute up to \$17,000 per year
- Contribute up to \$475,000 per account lifetime
- The assets in your Alabama ABLÉ account, up to \$100,000, will not affect your ability to receive state and federal benefits such as SSI (Supplemental Security Income) and Medicaid.
- For Alabama taxpayers, a deduction is allowed up to \$5,000 per taxpayer year for contributions into an Alabama ABLÉ account.
